5 form to the Office of the United States Trustee and mailed to counsel for the Committee and

15 this Application. If such an objection is filed, Debtor is authorized to pay the amounts, if
16 any, not subject to the objection. The Firm is informed and believes that this Cover Sheet
17 Application was mailed by first class mail, postage prepaid, on or about April 30, 2003.

18 9. The interim compensation and reimbursement of expenses sought in this
19 Application is on account and is not final. Upon the conclusion of this case, the Firm will
20 seek fees and reimbursement of the expenses incurred for the totality of the services
21 rendered in the case. Any interim fees or reimbursement of expenses approved by this Court
22 and received by the Firm (along with the Firm's retainer) will be credited against such final
23 fees and expenses as may be allowed by this Court.

24 10. The Firm represents and warrants that its billing practices comply with all

4 Order.


