20 (b) attached as Exhibit 2 are the detailed time and expense statements for the Application Period
21 that comply with all Northern District of California Bankruptcy Local Rules and Compensation
22 Guidelines and the Guidelines of the Office of the United States Trustee.

1 7. The Firm has served a copy of this Application (without Exhibits) on the
2 Special Notice List in this case.

3 8. Pursuant to this Court's "SECOND AMENDED ORDER ESTABLISHING
4 INTERIM FEE APPLICATION AND EXPENSE REIMBURSEMENT PROCEDURE" which
5 was issued March 18, 2002, the Debtor is authorized to make the payment requested herein
6 without a further hearing or order of this Court unless an objection to this Application is filed with
7 the Court by the Debtor, the Committee or the United States Trustee and served by the fifteenth
8 day of the month following the service of this Application. If such an objection is filed, Debtor is
9 authorized to pay the amounts, if any, not subject to the objection. The Firm is informed and
10 believes that this Cover Sheet Application was mailed by first class mail, postage prepaid, on or
11 about May 9, 2003.

12 9. This interim compensation and reimbursement of expenses sought in this
13 Application is on account and is not final. Upon the conclusion of this case, the Firm will seek
14 fees and reimbursement of the expenses incurred for the totality of the services rendered in the
15 case. Any interim fees or reimbursement of expenses approved by this Court and received by the
16 Firm (along with the Firm's retainer) will be credited against such final fees and expenses as may
17 be allowed by this Court.

18 10. The Firm represents and warrants that its billing practices comply with all

2 compensation to the Firm as requested herein pursuant to and in accordance with the terms of the
3 "SECOND AMENDED ORDER ESTABLISHING INTERIM FEE APPLICATION AND
4 EXPENSE REIMBURSEMENT PROCEDURE."
