

## OFFICE OF NUCLEAR SECURITY AND INCIDENT RESPONSE

### Notice of Final Rule Signed by EDO

On June 25, 2003, the Executive Director for Operations approved a final rule that amends certain sections of Part 95 of the regulations to reflect organizational changes resulting from the creation of the Office of Nuclear Security and Incident Response, to correct a minor error, and to change the derivative classification stamp in 10 CFR Part 95.37 per Executive Order 12958, "Classified National Security Information" and the relevant Implementing Directive. These amendments are being made in an immediately effective final rule because they concern agency organization and internal procedures, and a good cause finding has been made to dispense with the usual 30-day minimum delay in their effective date.

This notice informs the Commission that in accordance with the rulemaking authority delegated to the EDO, the EDO has signed this final rule and proposes to forward it on July 3, 2003, to the Office of the Federal Register for publication, unless otherwise directed by the Commission.

This final rule does not constitute a significant question of policy, nor does it amend regulations contained in 10 CFR Parts 7, 8, or 9, Subpart C, concerning matters of policy.
