Pursuant to 10 CFR 140.6(a), this submittal provides written notice of a claim involving alleged bodily injury arising out of, or in connection with, the use of radioactive material at Turkey Point Units 3 and 4.

On June 24, 2003, Adler Constant filed a Petition for Benefits with the State of Florida Office of the Judges of Compensation Claims against Florida Power and Light Company ("FPL"). In the Petition, Mr. Constant appears to allege that he cannot work because he has cancer allegedly caused by radiation exposure received at FPL's Turkey Point Plant.

FPL believes that the claim is wholly without merit and will vigorously contest the allegations contained therein.
