SUBJECT: ACCEPTANCE OF WCAP-15872, REVISION 00, "USE OF ALTERNATE
DECAY HEAT REMOVAL IN MODE 6 REFUELING" (TAC NO. MB9020)

Dear Mr. Bischoff:

By letter dated May 12, 2003, the Westinghouse Owners Group submitted for NRC staff review Topical Report (TR) WCAP-15872, Revision 00, "Use of Alternate Decay Heat Removal in Mode 6 Refueling." It also requested, consistent with the NRC Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation Instruction LIC-500, "Processing Requests for Reviews of Topical Reports," that the NRC provide an estimate of the review hours, as well as target dates for any requests for additional information (RAIs) and for completion of the safety evaluation (SE) for the TR.

The NRC staff has performed an acceptance review of WCAP-15872, Revision 00. We have found that the material presented is complete enough to begin a review. The staff expects to issue a request for additional information by August 15, 2003, and complete its review by January 28, 2004. It is estimated that the review will require approximately 300 staff hours.

Section 170.21 of Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations requires that TRs are subject to fees based on the full cost of the review. You did not request a fee waiver, therefore staff hours will be billed accordingly. To enable us to complete this review on schedule, close and frequent communications between our technical staffs will be required.
