# FALL 2003 CAMP MEETING

## General Information

The Fall 2003 CAMP meeting will be held from October 23 through October 25 in Baltimore, Maryland, USA. The general meeting will be held on the first two days and the TPC Meeting will be held on the morning of the third day, only if necessary.

Meetings will be held at the Days Inn Inner Harbor (web site - <http://www.daysinnerharbor.com>). Which is located in the heart of Baltimore's Inner Harbor area at 100 Hopkins Place. Each participant is responsible for arranging his/her lodging reservations. The following information is provided to assist you in making your travel arrangements and reservations.

## Reservations/Rates/Cancellations

**Reservations:** Reservations are to be made by the individual directly with the reservation department of the Days Inn Inner Harbor. When making reservations, prominently note that the reservation is for sleeping rooms associated with the "CAMP Meeting."

### Rate:

The special reduced conference rate is \$137 plus tax (currently 12.5%) for a single or double room.

### Timing:

**Early reservations are required.** All reservations must be completed by September 22, 2003. Late reservations will have to pay a substantially higher nightly rate. A number of rooms have been blocked for the CAMP meetings and these will be assigned on a first reserved, first taken basis. When making your reservation, please request the group rate for the "CAMP Meeting."

**Guarantee:** Your reservation request will be confirmed and guaranteed by using a major credit card. Most major credit cards are accepted for your convenience.



Cancellation Policy: In the event of a cancellation, you must cancel your reservation at least 24 hours in advance to prevent having to forfeit the non-refundable deposit. Make sure that you get a cancellation number.

Travel from the Airport:

The preferred airport is the Baltimore-Washington International Airport (BWI). There is light rail service from the airport to downtown Baltimore (exit at the Pratt Street/Convention Center station). Riding time is approximately 25 minutes. The hotel is within walking distance. Taxi fare from the airport to the hotel should be around \$20. Super Shuttle (1-800-258-3826) also services BWI. The shuttle fare from the airport to the hotel should be around \$10.

From Dulles International Airport or Reagan National Airport, one can take the inter-airport bus to BWI and then proceed as noted above. Alternatives from Reagan and Dulles airports include Super Shuttle and taxi service at substantially higher cost.

Parking is available at the hotel at \$12 per day.

Travel from the Marriott at Metro Center in Washington, D.C. (Nuclear Safety Research Conference)

Take the Washington Metro Red Line to Union Station. Purchase a ticket on the MARC Penn Line (\$6.00) from Union Station to the BWI Station (service operates Monday through Friday only). From BWI stop take the shuttle bus (free) to the BWI Air Terminal and walk to the North End where the Light Rail stop is located. Purchase a token/pass and take the Light Rail into Baltimore and exit at the Pratt Street/Convention Center stop. The Days Inn Hotel is 1 block away (NW direction). Alternatives include taxi service at substantially higher cost.
