Building Permits

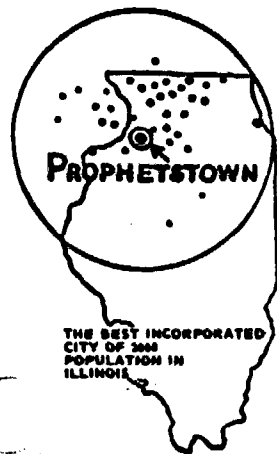
Building permits were issued to Don Donegan, Al. Wade, Craig Leigh, Wesley Grau and Merle Strike.
