<p>Summary:</p> <p>One of the documents submitted by CFC with its letter dated April 22, 2003, included Test Record of Leaktightness of the pool. The date on this record was 7-11-02. I called Russell to verify if this was July 11, 2002, or (November 7, 2002, according to English practice).</p> <p>He confirmed that the test was in deed performed in July of 2002. He also stated that the irradiator project actually started on February 18, 2002, and it was not for CFC Logistics, but was originally being built for a company in New Jersey. However, the company merged with another company and the new company did not need the irradiator. Later CFC Logistics, became interested in the irradiator.</p> <p>During my first visit to CFC Logistics, Inc. I was told that all of the drawings may be made publicly available, and the notation on the drawings that they be not released without Clayton-Layton's permission, can be ignored because it is a boiler plate that goes on all of their drawings. Russell Stein confirmed that all of the drawings may be released for access to public.</p>
