TITLE: RESOLUTION ADVISING SECRETARY OF HOMELAND SECURITY, THOMAS RIDGE, THE SECURITY AND EVACUATION CONCERNS AT THE OYSTER CREEK NUCLEAR POWER PLANT

Committeeman Broderick presents the following resolution.

WHEREAS, there have been repeated complaints from the Jersey Shore Nuclear Watch and others that the Oyster Creek Nuclear Power Plant in the Township of Lacey has not provided adequate security or an adequate evacuation plan in the event of an emergency; and

WHEREAS, these complaints have been buttressed by the TV news reports regarding alleged security lapses; and

WHEREAS, State Senator Leonard R. Connors has noted that "what does it say about security there, when you can drive leisurely around the grounds at a nuclear power plant in a van with a video camera in your hand without ever being stopped and questioned?" and

WHEREAS, the Asbury Park Press has raised similar concerns; and

WHEREAS, our Country is at war and faces the increased risk of terrorist attacks; and

WHEREAS, the response of Oyster Creek has been neither satisfactory nor reassuring; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Jackson believes such concerns should be brought to the attention of Thomas Ridge, Secretary to the Department of Homeland Security; and
