I am requesting documents pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. §552 et seq. ("FOIA"), involving correspondence and other information requested by or provided to the following current Member of the US Senate between January 1, 1999 and March 11, 2003.

I seek all direct correspondence between the listed member or their staff and your Agency, including letters, reports, requests and other relevant material. I am not seeking any secondary material such as phone logs, e-mails, notations of conversations and so on.

Congress wrote the Freedom of Information Act so that the American people, who do not have the power of subpoena, are guaranteed a broad right to know about the operations and activities of their government and its officials, consistent with personal privacy. Therefore, please release any material that may be reasonably separated and released, as provided by Agency rules in the Code of Federal Regulations. In particular, information regarding individuals (other than the members of Congress listed in this request) should be redacted where disclosure would be an unwarranted invasion of individual privacy. [Per the exemption provided by Congress in 5 U.S.C. 552(b)(6)]

I also request that you state the specific legal and factual grounds for withholding any documents or portions of documents. And please identify each document that falls with scope of this request but is withheld from release.


If requested documents are located in, or originated in, another installation or bureau, please refer this request or any relevant portion of this request to the appropriate installation or bureau.
