ORDER

Before EBEL, Circuit Judge, BRORBY, Senior Circuit Judge, and HENRY, Circuit Judge.

This case is before the court based on a motion by Respondent-Intervenor Private Fuel Storage to dismiss the petition for review based on lack of finality, and the motion by Respondent United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission to hold the case in abeyance.

Ohngo Gaudadeh Devia seeks review of an October 1, 2002 Order of the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission.

The court lacks appellate jurisdiction. The October 1, 2002 Order is not final. It did not "dispose[] of all issues as to all parties in the licensing proceeding." *Commonwealth of Massachusetts v. NRC*, 924 F.2d 311, 322 (D.C. Cir.), *cert. denied*, 502 U.S. 899 (1991). Furthermore, Petitioner Ohngo Gaudadeh Devia has failed to demonstrate that any exception to the finality requirement applies in this case.

The motion to hold case in abeyance is denied. When a petition for review is filed before an agency order is final, subsequent action by the agency does not ripen the petition for review. *See Melcher v. FCC*, 134 F.3d 1143, 1163 (D.C. Cir. 1998).

Accordingly, the motion to dismiss is GRANTED. The motion to hold case in abeyance is DENIED. The petition for review is DISMISSED for lack of appellate jurisdiction. The mandate will issue forthwith.
