In response to FOIA 2001-0358, Beth Wetzel identified inspection reports regarding the key card security system at Point Beach.

In light of the current heightened security environment, the FOIA Branch provided the following information describing how the agency is processing FOIA requests. Please review the following info and **notify me ASAP whether or not NRR should identify the inspection reports has possibly having security-related concerns.** I know John Zwolinski stated that the incoming FOIA request should be identified as a concern and I am including such a statement in NRR's response back to the FOIA Branch.

{FOIA BRANCH: "If you believe under the current heightened security environment the records contain information that warrant closer scrutiny, please list these records on a separate appendix and provide a harm statement explaining the sensitivity of the information.

For information withholdable under Exemption 3, Unclassified Safeguards Information, indicate in the margin of the record the section(s) of 10 CFR 73.21 under which the bracketed information falls.

For your information, copies of FOIA requests are being provided to the OEDO if it is apparent from the incoming request that security information is being requested.")
