Dear Mr. Sheppard:

By letter dated August 20, 2002, as supplemented by letter dated January 6, 2003, STP Nuclear Operating Company (STPNOC) requested approval, in accordance with the provisions of 50.55a(a)(3)(i) of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations*, of an alternative to ASME Section XI, paragraph IWL-2421 (b), which specifies the inservice inspection intervals to be applied in examination of containment concrete and unbonded post-tensioning systems, and IWL-2521, which describes the tendon selection process. By letter dated August 26, 2003, STPNOC withdrew the August 20, 2002, request for ASME Code Relief.
