**WITHDRAWAL OF LICENSE AMENDMENT REQUEST REGARDING MISSED
SURVEILLANCE AND ADOPTION OF A TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION BASES CONTROL
PROGRAM USING THE CONSOLIDATED LINE ITEM IMPROVEMENT PROCESS**

Ladies and Gentlemen:

In a letter dated September 26, 2002, Carolina Power & Light Company (CP&L) requested an amendment to the Technical Specifications (TS) for the Harris Nuclear Plant (HNP) to modify the TS requirements for missed surveillances in Surveillance Requirement (SR) 4.0.3 and to add a TS requirement for a TS Bases control program in Administrative Controls Section 6.16. On March 6, 2003, the NRC provided to HNP guidance concerning the adoption of TSTF-358, Rev 6, by non-Standard Technical Specification (STS) plants beyond the requirements stated in the Federal Register notice (FR 49714).

HNP is not prepared to adapt TS 3.0.1 through 3.0.7 with the associated surveillance requirements and bases to Standard Technical Specifications at this time. Therefore, HNP requests withdrawal of the license amendment request.
