**Withdrawal of License Amendment Request 01-12**  
**Associated With Changes to Spent Fuel Assembly Storage Technical Specification 3/4.9.13**

FPL Energy Seabrook, LLC (FPLE Seabrook) hereby withdraws License Amendment Request (LAR) 01-12 submitted by letter NYN-02024, dated March 22, 2002. LAR 01-12 proposed changes to the Seabrook Station Technical Specifications for spent fuel storage to reflect a two-zone spent fuel pool consisting of BORAFLEX® and BORAL® fuel assembly storage racks. Withdrawal of LAR 01-12 is predicated on evaluation of an unexpected degradation mechanism associated with the BORAL® fuel assembly storage racks. FPLE Seabrook expects to re-submit a revised License Amendment Request once the issue is evaluated.
