Please publish the following reports:

- 1) NUREG-1754 "A New Comparative Analysis of LWR Fuel Designs"
- 2) NUREG/CR-6744 "Phenomenon Identification and Ranking Tables (PIRTs) for Loss-of-Coolant Accidents in Pressurized and Boiling Water Reactors Containing High Burnup Fuel"

Both documents have been reviewed against: 1) the draft criteria, presently at the Commission for approval, for discretionary release of information to the public, and 2) factors for staff consideration provided by the EDO in a memorandum dated December 5, 2001. Based on this sensitivity review it has been determined that the contents of NUREG -1754 and NUREG/CR-6744 are benign and contain no sensitive information that can be misused by those with malevolent intentions toward NRC-regulated facilities and activities. The results of the reviews have been approved by Thomas King, the cognizant RES Division Director.

RES PROCEDURES FOR RELEASE OF NONSENSITIVE DOCUMENTS

A senior technical person in RES is to review the document against both the Commission's draft criteria and the criteria in W.D. Travers' December 5, 2001, memo to the Commission. If the document is determined to be nonsensitive and benign, the senior technical person is to notify, by email, the document's project manager and the pertinent RES Division Director. This Division Director is to email a request to release the document to Gil Millman (Mabel Lee in Gil's absence), stating that the document has been reviewed against the Commission's draft criteria and the criteria in Travers' memo and that the document has been found to be benign and nonsensitive.

Gil Millman (or Mabel Lee) will forward the request for release of the document (including the determination that the document is benign and nonsensitive) to Mindy Landau, who will then release the document for public availability.
