Subject: Approval for RG Reposting

Attached is the list of Regulatory Guides (RGs) that were posted to the NRC public web site prior to 9/11. These RGs were subsequently removed from the site. They will be reposted when reviewed and approved for release.

A team composed of Ed Hackett, Frank Coffman, and I reviewed all active Division 1 (Power Reactor) RGs previously posted on the NRC site against the Commission Guidance provided in COMSECY-01-0030 (This guidance (attached) does not provide specific criteria, but does indicate how the staff should revise the original draft staff criteria which were disapproved by the Commission). The results of the team review are contained in the attached table with the list of guides. Most of the guides were determined to be immediately acceptable for reposting. The remainder required further review, for various reasons, and are indicated with a TBD.

The attached table has the RGs sorted according to Division cognizance. The team related each guide to a division; if you feel the designation should be revised for any RG assigned to your division, or assigned to another division, or designated TBD for division, please let me know.

Please review the team's recommendations (indicated in the Publish to Web column of attached table) for release of RGs that fall within your branch. Based upon this review, please do the following: 1) Indicate your acceptance/disapproval of the recommendation for release for each RG attributed to your division that is within your branch (you may indicate this in the body of an e-mail or in the App. column in the table; 2) Forward your list of approval/disapproval to D:DET for final approval and subsequent forward to me; 3) Indicate any RGs that, in your view, should be reassigned to/from your division.

Please forward your response to D:DET by Thursday, February 28.
