Please repost the following Division 6 and Division 7 regulatory guides to the NRC public web site.

**RG 6.9, "Establishing Quality Assurance Programs for the Manufacture and Distribution of Sealed Sources and Devices Containing Byproduct Material"**

**RG 7.11, "Fracture Toughness Criteria of Base Material for Ferritic Steel Shipping Cask Containment Vessels with a Maximum Wall Thickness of 4 Inches (0.1 m)"**

**RG 7.12, "Fracture Toughness Criteria of Base Material for Ferritic Steel Shipping Cask Containment Vessels with a Wall Thickness Greater than 4 Inches (0.1 m) But Not Exceeding 12 Inches (0.3 m)"**

These regulatory guides have been reviewed and approved by NMSS staff responsible for homeland security sensitivity reviews. The review was based on Commission guidance (dated January 25, 2002) to the staff for developing final criteria for release of information to the public. Based on these sensitivity reviews, I can verify that the above regulatory guides do not contain information that could provide a clear and significant benefit to a terrorist in a potential attack.
