**2) NUREG-1717, "Systematic Radiological Assessment of Exemptions for Source and Byproduct Materials"**

These NUREGs have been reviewed based on information in COMSECY-01-0030 (January 25, 2002) which provides the latest Commission guidance to the staff on development of criteria for release of information to the public. Based on these sensitivity reviews, it has been determined that the contents of NUREG-0713 (Vol.22) and NUREG-1717 do not contain information that could provide a clear and significant benefit to a terrorist in a potential attack. The result of the review (attached) has been approved by Farouk Eltawila (D:DSARE), the cognizant RES Division Director.

Electronic files for the subject NUREGs are attached. NUREG-0713 is attached as nureg2000.pdf. NUREG-1717, because of its size, is provided as two separate WP files (ToPubPart1.wpd and ToPubPart2.wpd), which should be merged for posting to the web.
