AND PHYSICAL FITNESS APPLICABLE TO ARMED NUCLEAR POWER PLANT
SECURITY FORCE PERSONNEL DATED APRIL 29, 2003

On April 29, 2003, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) issued an Order for compensatory measures (CMs) related to training enhancements on tactical and firearms proficiency and physical fitness applicable to armed nuclear power plant security force personnel (EA-03-039) (the Order). Virginia Electric and Power Company (Dominion) and Dominion Nuclear Connecticut, Inc. (DNC) submitted an answer to the Order on May 30, 2003 (Serial Nos. 03-333 and B18909).

On September 22, 2003, a conference call was held with NRC staff to discuss Dominion's and DNC's response to CMs in the Order. As a result of this conference call, we are revising our response to CMs C.4.a and C.4.b as well as our Note 1. These items are provided in the attachment. The responses provided in the attachment supercede the responses for those specific CMs that were provided in our May 30, 2003 letter.

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

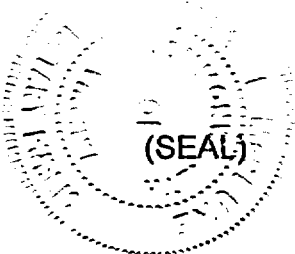
