My staff and staff from IEPB and SPSB have reviewed the Environmental Report (ER) and the site redress plan included in the Exelon Generation Company Early Site Permit application dated September 25, 2003, for an early site permit (ESP) at the Clinton Power Station site. The associated sections of the application are Parts 3 and 4 (the ER and the site redress plan). The staff concludes that the ER and site redress plan addresses all of the pertinent aspects required to begin the environmental review for an early site permit and is acceptable for docketing. However, some of the review areas may require supplemental information to complete the review. The staff expects that some of the needed information will be gathered during the site audit scheduled for the week of March 1, 2004, and the remainder will be the subject of requests for additional information.
