RE: Lost Nuclecel static eliminator

To whom it may concern,

On October 10, 2003 we, Summit Polymers, Inc. Plant One, became aware of a missing Nuclecel static eliminator manufactured by NRD, Inc., which we were leasing from Amstat Industries. When became aware of the missing unit when we were contacted by Amstat Industries to replace the unit because the 1 year lease had expired.

The lost unit was a Nuclecel Model P-2021-8101 In-line Ionizer. The Serial number was A2CG769.

The unit was last used in June 2003 prior to us removing a paint booth in which the unit was used to remove static from plastic parts prior to painting. We have contacted everyone involved in the paint booth removal asking if they had the unit in their possession. We also looked in our recycled metals container to see if it had mistakenly been disposed of there and possibly still in the container. We have been unsuccessful in locating the missing device.

Our intention is to replace this type of static eliminator with a model that is hard plumbed into the air line making it more difficult to remove. This will make the item more difficult to remove and help us prevent loss.
