Request for Two Month Extension of the Letter Amendment to Certificate of Compliance No. 71-9248 for the Model SP-1, SP-2 and SP-3 Packages

The purpose of this letter is to request a two month extension of the expiration date of the letter amendment that was granted for Certificate of Compliance No. 71-9248 as a result of Reference 1. The new expiration date would be February 28, 2004, which is the same date the current certificate expires. A customer has identified a need for the low enriched no gadolinia fuel bundle approved in the letter amendment. The fuel would be shipped in mid February 2004.

A request to make the fuel category approved in the letter amendment a permanent fuel category for the certificate has been made in Reference 2.
