On April 29, 2003 the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) issued an Order for Compensatory Measures Related to Fitness-For-Duty Enhancements Applicable to Nuclear Facility Security Force Personnel, Order EA-03-038 (the Order). In a May 30, 2003 letter (Serial Nos. 03-332 and B18911) Virginia Electric and Power Company and Dominion Nuclear Connecticut, Inc. (Dominion and DNC) submitted an answer to the Order, requested an extension of time to submit information and request a hearing, and requested information on the bases of the Order. The NRC responded to our May 30, 2003 letter in a July 10, 2003 letter. In that letter the NRC required an additional response from Dominion and DNC. Dominion and DNC provided the additional response and requested relief from certain Order requirements in a letter dated July 24, 2003 (Serial Nos. 03-417 and B18941). The NRC granted relaxation from certain requirements of the Order and provided revised Compensatory Measures in an October 23, 2003 letter.


The purpose of this letter is to inform you that North Anna, Surry and Millstone Power Stations are in compliance with the Order as modified by the NRC's October 23, 2003

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
