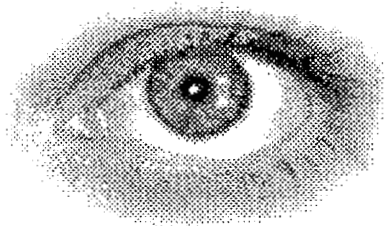
Mr Caldwell from what I saw in the Plain Dealer I am concerned about a disaster and danger for the population. You should act on the fact of safety.
