The team leader for the development of the construction inspection program from the Inspection Program Branch, and the Program Director for New, Research and Test Reactors, made a one-hour presentation to the Nuclear Energy Institute's task force on new nuclear plants. The purpose of the presentation was to brief the task force on the status of the revision to the construction inspection program and challenges associated with the NRC supporting the aggressive construction schedules envisioned by some vendors. The staff stressed the need for the industry to share its plans regarding construction of new nuclear plants as early in the process as possible so that the NRC can ensure that the appropriate resources and infrastructure are in place to support the industry's construction efforts.
