SYNOPSIS

This investigation was initiated on August 19, 2002, by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Office of Investigations, Region III, to determine if a former Chemistry Technician at the D.C. Cook Nuclear Power Plant (Cook) was discriminated against in violation of 10 CFR 50.7 and 50.5 for raising procedural concerns.

Based upon the evidence developed, this investigation did not substantiate the allegation that a former Chemistry Technician at Cook was discriminated against in violation of 10 CFR 50.7 and 50.5 for raising procedural concerns.
