Dear Sir:

Under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act, as amended (5 USC 552), I am requesting release of any and all documents your agency may have pertaining to the establishment or future establishment of a nuclear waste storage or disposal facility in the state of Alabama.

Also, I am requesting the names of all such facilities in the United States now under development or consideration, as well as the names and addresses of companies or corporations involved.

I expect, as provided in 5 USC 552(b), that "(a)ny reasonably segregable portion of a record shall be provided...after deletion of the portions exempt."

If any portion of this request is denied or if any portion of any document is withheld in whole or in part, however, I request a letter explaining your legal justification for doing so.

I believe these documents to be of primary interest to the general public and request a waiver of charges as allowed in section a4a.

If any search or copying fees are required, I ask that you notify me in advance of the probable cost.

I look forward to hearing from you within 10 days as the law specifies.
