
Nuclear Fuel Services, Inc. (NFS) hereby submits a revised schedule for completing the Integrated Safety Analysis (ISA) Summary for existing plant processes related to the KAST Fuel Manufacturing and Uranium Recovery Process (300 Complex), the Research & Development Laboratory (Building 110), the Waste Water Treatment Process (Building 330) and the Building 310 Warehouse. While efforts to complete the ISA Summary for these processes are currently underway, competing priorities have resulted in delays in completing this task by the earlier projected date of February 2004 (Reference 2). NFS will submit the ISA Summary for the aforementioned processes and applicable support areas by October 18, 2004, in accordance with Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 70.62 (c)(3)(ii). NFS hopes that this revised schedule is useful to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's efforts in planning the necessary resources to complete the licensing reviews of the ISA Summary.
