NRC STAFF'S RESPONSE TO  
APPLICANT'S PROPOSED REDACTIONS  
SUBMITTED ON JANUARY 20, 2004

Pursuant to the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board's January 5, 2004 "Memorandum and Order (Granting in Part and Denying in Part Motion for Reconsideration and/or Clarification of Financial Qualifications Decisions)" (Reconsideration M&O), the NRC Staff (Staff) hereby files its response to the Applicant's proposed redactions of the Board's January 5, 2004 Memorandum and Order.<sup>1</sup>

The Staff has previously stated its view that the Applicant's proposed redactions generally appear to be reasonable, although the Staff disagreed with a limited number of the Applicant's proposed redactions. See Joint Filing at 2, and Table attached thereto. The Staff had previously stated similar views with respect to the Applicant's July 3, 2003, request for redaction of other Board decisions on financial assurance.<sup>2</sup> In order to avoid unnecessary repetition, the Staff herein
