This is a followup to our telephone conversation earlier this month, in which you requested Department of Energy (DOE) documents concerning four sites:

- Superior Steel, Carnegie, Pennsylvania;
- Jessop Steel, Washington, Pennsylvania;
- Baker & Company, Newark, New Jersey; and
- Firth Sterling, Pittsburg, Pennsylvania.

The DOE Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program (FUSRAP) has documents relating to the first three facilities, and all available documents are enclosed. In the case of the Firth Sterling facility, no documents were identified, and FUSRAP has no record of activities at that site involving DOE's predecessor.
