SUMMARY

1) DOE-RL is preparing a letter which proposes guidelines for workshops and discusses future planned workshops.

2) Re: future workshops:

a) RHO will telephone soon with comments on the agenda for the October 4 design workshop. A proposed agenda was telefaxed <sup>to DOE</sup> on September 1.

b) The geologic stability workshop, now scheduled on October 4, must be postponed until February 1983. Main reason given - pressure of work on the SCR.

c) The performance assessment workshop, which had been proposed by RHO in August and which we had suggested to be held October 18, needs "to be put on the back burner." Reasons given - (1) pressure of work on the SCR and (2) some attention was given to P.A. in the July hydrogeology workshop and the August waste package/geochemistry workshop. I mentioned that the second reason is faulty: no attention was given to numerical P.A. (3) in response to our 8/5/82 letter of inquiry, sealing of the E.S. will be conventional for a bored shaft. Reasons: 1) uncertainty whether the E.S. will be part of a
