SUBJECT: IDENTIFICATION OF AND ACCESS TO NRC APPROVED SITE SECURITY PLANS AND
NUCLEAR MATERIALS CONTROL AND SAFEGUARDS PLANS

This is in response to the letter of inquiry to John Linehan from J. O. Neff (Program Manager, SALT, DOE) dated March 14, 1984, requesting identification or copies of subject plans. I have discussed this question with Robert Dube, Fuel Facility Safeguards Licensing Branch, NMSS, NRC. He has indicated the following:

1. There are NRC-approved security plans for a fuel fabrication facility and for the GE Morris Illinois spent fuel storage facility. The former information is classified, the latter is not classified. The applicability of these plans to a high-level waste repository is however questionable.
2. As far as NRC-developed plans for a high-level waste repository, there is nothing in existence at this time and no planned development at least through FY85.
3. Major changes to site design is not anticipated as a consequence of NRC site security reviews.
