re: Request for Correction of Erratum in CLI-04-04 (Docket No. 72-22-ISFSI)

The State of Utah was served by electronic mail today with Memorandum and Order, CLI-04-04, relating to the Commission's consideration of petitions for review of interlocutory Board orders (other than those relating to matters still awaiting final Board decision) filed by Utah and Ohngo Gaudadeh Devia.

In rejecting Utah's petition for review of Utah Security A (Security Implications of Lack of Nearby Housing), the Commission said: "It appears that Utah's contention results from a misinterpretation of Utah's security plan." CLI-04-04, slip op at 3 (*emphasis added*). The State of Utah has no security plan for the PFS facility and it requests that CLI-04-04 be revised to correct that misapprehension. It appears that the word "PFS's" should replace "Utah's" in the foregoing sentence.

The State requests correction of CLI-04-04 as described above.
