SUBJECT: SRP SITE REPORT FOR THE WEEK OF MAY 28, 1984

1. My discussions with you and with the other members of your staff on May 29 and 30 were very useful. I strongly believe that a direct feedback from you and other technical and management members of your staff is critical for efficiency and effectiveness of our jobs in the field. My detailed discussions with Linehan, Johnson, Kennedy, Justus, Miller, Knapp, and Bunting were stimulating and important in helping me focus my interactions with DOE and their contractors.
2. On May 31, 1984, I attended the Sixth Bimonthly Meeting with Salt States representatives and DOE. Representatives from the State of Texas did not attend. Topics that were of interest to NRC included Environmental Assessments and Transportation. SRPO and their contractors and subcontractors have prepared seven EA's. A fourth draft of these seven EA's has been sent to the Salt States and NRC. Salt States representatives were quite concerned about the quality of the database in the EA's and also about the inconsistency in the quantity and quality of the available database for the different basins. A copy of the agenda is attached.
3. On June 1, 1984, I attended the DOE briefing for the First Repository States and affected Indian Tribes. Representatives from the six host states and the Indian Nations of Yakima and Umatilla were present. A copy of the agenda is attached. There were numerous questions regarding the criterion for the interbasin comparison for site selection for characterization.
