On Thursday, August 30, I stopped by the U.S. National Park Service (NPS) Office in Denver, Colorado to talk to Mr. Cecil Lewis. This was a courtesy call made while I was in Denver on other Business.

Among other things, Mr. Lewis clarified the NPS issues and concerns from the NPS letter of 4/4/84 (WM-16) to NRC. Of the issues and concerns listed in the NPS letter, some are undergoing study by the NPS.

Two ongoing studies include a visibility study (in its 6th year) and a study relating to PSD National Ambient Air Quality Standards (in its 5th year). Other ongoing studies include a Night Sky Brightness study (expected to be concluded Dec. '84) and a Noise Protection study (first year in December).

I was able to obtain some maps of southeast Utah and specific information on the Canyonlands park.

All in all, it was a successful visit. The NPS was able to fully clarify their issues and concerns listed in the NPS letter and understand that NRC will seriously consider their issues and concerns in our review of the EAs. They appreciated NRC making the effort to come by their office for this courtesy call.
