ORDER


Judge Baratta and the undersigned will conduct a telephone conference with the parties to this materials licensing proceeding at 11:00 a.m. (EST) on Wednesday, February 4, 2004. Because, as matters now stand, the single purpose of the conference will be to determine a schedule for the filing of the written presentations called for by 10 C.F.R. § 2.1233, there does not currently appear to be any necessity to have the conference stenographically recorded. Should any party wish, however, to address at the conference other subjects of a possibly more substantial or controversial character, it should so notify all concerned by electronic mail no later than noon (EST) on Monday, February 2, 2004. The notice should identify with particularity the other subjects which the party will wish to be addressed.

The parties might wish to consult among themselves in advance of the conference in an endeavor to reach agreement on a schedule. In that connection, it is contemplated that, first, the Petitioners will file their written presentations. The Licensee and NRC Staff then will respond to those presentations, following which the Petitioners will have an opportunity to reply to the responses. There seems offhand no good reason why the entire process should not be completed by the end of May 2004.


