Dear Mr. Davis:

This is to acknowledge and thank you for your correspondence of September 13, 1983, concerning NRC-State relations relative to high level nuclear waste.

As your letter stated, the DOE consultation process as required by the Nuclear Waste Policy Act of 1982 has been initiated in Louisiana, and we would desire a parallel structure for our relationship with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC). The point of contact I have designated in both cases is Dr. L. Hall Bohlinger, Deputy Assistant Secretary, Office of Environmental Affairs, Louisiana Department of Natural Resources, Baton Rouge, Louisiana 70804. I am additionally advising the legislative leadership by copy of this letter and recommending a coordinated designation as suggested by the NRC.
