SUMMARY

In response to my call, Mr. Thompson called back to inform me that DOE-RL

cannot support a hydrology data review for the Hanford site during the week of

September 22, 1986. He requested that we postpone the review until after DOE

has identified tentative dates for the NRC-DOE meeting about hydrology testing

at the Hanford site. Mr. Thompson informed me that DOE has requested RHO to

provide a schedule for the development of the strategy to enable DOE to schedule

presentations about the strategy with DOE-HQ and NRC. He also stated that

initiation of drilling DC-24/25 is now contingent on successful completion of

the NRC-DOE hydrology testing meeting and readiness reviews for the drilling

activities. According to DOE-RL management, a date must be set for the hydrology

testing meeting before scheduling the hydrology data review. I commented that

conduct of the data review prior to the testing meeting would provide NRC with

more insight into the status of current activities at the site and allow the

NRC-DOE testing meeting to be more constructive. Mr. Thompson also informed

that DOE-RL has decided to postpone radioactive tracer injection in DC-23 (using
