SUMMARY

Per my October 6 conversation with Mr. Warren Bishop, Chairman of the Nuclear Waste Board, I had tried to contact Mr. Don Provost in the Office of High-Level Nuclear Waste Management in the Department of Ecology to request pertinent information. Mr. Provost returned my call at 3:30 pm. I told him that I needed information on the Referendum 40 so as to get things into perspective. (I am still unsure exactly what Referendum 40 entails.) He said that the first of 5 public information hearings on Ref. 40 would be held on Oct. 14 and that he would send me the final package tomorrow or Thursday. He did not explain what Ref. 40 concerned. I also asked him to send me any information concerning the Washington State Government Organization, so that I can get a perspective on where the Department of Ecology, the Nuclear Waste Board, the Department of Health and Social Services, etc. influence the nuclear waste program.
