SUBJECT: Nov. 15 T.F. Meeting and NRC Briefing

Our latest contact with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) indicates that they will not have an agenda formalized until early the week of November 8, 1982. Rather than waiting for receipt of this formal agenda, I am relaying to you its probable content in this memorandum.

The task force will hold its meeting beginning at 10:00 a.m. in the Governor's Conference Room on November 15, 1982. The foremost order of business will be continued discussion of the task force work plan. Following the task force meeting we will break for lunch and reconvene at 1:30 p.m. for the NRC briefing.

The NRC is planning to give a short historical overview of their agency and its roots in the Atomic Energy Commission. They will then review the proposed licensing procedures for a geologic repository and state participation in this process. The NRC staff will also discuss their plans for reviewing the U. S. Department of Energy Site Characterization Report. It is expected that there will be a generous allotment of time for questions and discussion prior to 5:00 p.m.
