SUBJECT: DOE Briefing on SCR

This memorandum is to notify you that the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) will be in Olympia on December 6, 1982 to brief the task force on the Site Characterization Report (SCR). The meeting will begin at 10:00 a.m. in the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council (EFSEC) Hearing Room.

The meeting will be conducted in two parts; a morning session, which will be a management oriented overview requiring about one and one-half to two hours, and an afternoon technical review lasting approximately four hours. For the latter session task force members may wish to have additional staff in attendance with expertise in specific areas. The SCR covers a multitude of technical areas and the depth to which DOE Staff will delve into each of these is still sketchy at this time. We have been informed that the briefing team will likely consist of at least one key author from each of the SCR's major areas: hydrological, geological, engineering, planning, and perhaps Mr. Larry Fitch who coordinated much of the SCR effort.

We have one advance copy of the SCR in the EFSEC office and, if you wish, please come in and peruse the table of contents or a section of special interest. We are expecting to receive additional copies for each of the task force members by the end of November, if DOE's printing goes as planned.
