PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE: October 1, 2003 to September 30, 2004

STATEMENT OF WORK: As directed by the Center for Nuclear Waste Regulatory Analyses (CNWRA) project manager, Dr. Bryan will participate with CNWRA staff in multidisciplinary teams to prepare responses to public comments received on the draft environmental impact statement (EIS) for the proposed Idaho Spent Fuel Facility at Idaho National Engineering and Environmental Laboratory (INEEL). As appropriate, Dr. Bryan will assist the CNWRA staff to revise the draft EIS and prepare a final EIS. His focus will be on those areas in socioeconomics and environmental justice where CNWRA does not have staff expertise. As appropriate, Dr. Bryan may be asked to conduct literature and data searches, review materials provided by the NRC and its licensees, conduct site visits, and participate in public meetings related to NRC environmental activities. Dr. Bryan will document his work and provide the CNWRA project manager with written reports on a schedule consistent with the project deliverable schedule, and in a form suitable for inclusion in the final EIS and other CNWRA deliverables to NRC. As part of this work, he may be asked to visit CNWRA offices in San Antonio, Texas or NRC headquarters in Rockville, Maryland.

ESTIMATED UTILIZATION (hours): 80 hours

PRIOR CONTRACTOR WORK EXPERIENCE WITH SWRI: Dr. Bryan worked with the CNWRA staff during FY2003 to prepare the socioeconomic and environmental justice sections for the draft EIS for the proposed Idaho Spent Fuel Facility. The proposed statement of work represents a continuation and completion of his earlier work for the CNWRA.
