The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection's (NJDEP) Radiation Protection Program is submitting the following comment on the February 4, 2004 document: (Docket No. 030-05222) *Environmental Assessment Related to an Amendment of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission Materials License No. 29-00139-02, Issued to E.R. Squibb & Sons, Incorporated.*

The NJDEP reviewed the September 2003 Final Status Survey (FSS) referenced in the February 4, 2004 document and through subsequent correspondence with E. R. Squibb and Sons (Squibb) has determined that both the soil and buildings comply with the Department's remediation criteria of 15 mrem/yr.

The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection's Radiation Protection Program agrees with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Environmental Assessment conclusion that a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) is appropriate for the proposed action of releasing a portion of the licensee's facilities in New Brunswick, New Jersey, for unrestricted use.
