**APPLICANT'S MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME IN  
WHICH TO SUBMIT PROPRIETARY REDACTIONS FOR CLI-04-10**

On March 24, 2004, the Commission issued CLI-04-10<sup>1</sup> ruling on the petitions for review filed by Applicant Private Fuel Storage, L.L.C. ("PFS") and the State of Utah ("State") with respect to decisions by the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board ("Licensing Board") concerning financial qualifications and decommissioning funding. Because the Commission's decision discusses PFS's financial plan and contains proprietary information, the Commission allowed 14 days after the decision's issuance for any party to submit to the Commission a designation of appropriate redactions of proprietary information contained in the decision.

Subsequently, on March 31, 2004, the Licensing Board issued a Memorandum and Order<sup>2</sup> ruling on redactions requested by PFS of proprietary and confidential information from the evidentiary and decisional materials relating to Contentions Utah E/Confederated Tribes F ("Utah E") and Utah S. Petitions requesting Commission review of the Licensing Board's Memorandum and Order are due April 15, 2004.

PFS is in the process of reviewing the Licensing Board's Memorandum and Order and the underlying materials to determine whether it will seek Commission review regarding



any of the materials ordered to be disclosed by the Licensing Board. PFS's submission to the Commission of appropriate redactions of proprietary information contained in CLI-04-10 will depend in part on whether PFS requests Commission review of the release of any of the evidentiary or decisional material encompassed by the Licensing Board's March 31, 2004 Memorandum and Order. Accordingly, PFS requests that the time for the parties to submit to the Commission appropriate redactions of proprietary information contained in CLI-04-10 be extended to Tuesday, April 13, 2004.

Counsel for PFS has contacted counsel for the NRC Staff and for the State of Utah and is authorized to represent that neither objects to the requested extension.

Wherefore, PFS respectfully requests that the time for any party to submit to the Commission a designation of appropriate redactions of proprietary information contained in CLI-04-10 be extended to Tuesday, April 13, 2004.

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
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
