MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

Judge Cole and this presiding officer will hold a telephone conference with counsel for the parties to this materials license amendment proceeding at 9:00 a.m. (EDT) on Wednesday, April 28, 2004. Because the principal purpose of the conference will be to establish a schedule for the filing of the written presentations, it is not currently planned to have it stenographically recorded. Should, however, a party intend to raise at the conference an additional matter of a possibly controversial nature, counsel should provide notice to that effect no later than noon on Monday, April 26.

In advance of the conference, counsel might wish to confer among themselves in an endeavor to reach agreement on a schedule. In that connection, it is our contemplation that the Petitioners (State of Franklin Group of the Sierra Club et al.) will file and serve their opening written presentation; the Licensee and the NRC Staff will then contemporaneously file and serve their responsive written presentations; following which, if so inclined, the Petitioners may

file and serve a rebuttal written presentation. It is further contemplated that all written presentations will be on file no later than August 31, 2004.¹

¹In LBP-04-05, 59 NRC__ (March 17, 2004), the hearing requests of Kathy Helms-Hughes (among others) were denied for lack of the requisite standing. On April 7, in LBP-04-06, 59 NRC __, a document Ms. Helms-Hughes had filed with the presiding officer on April 1 was referred by him to the Commission for its possible consideration as an appeal from the denial of her hearing requests. In the event that, prior to April 28, the Commission shall have taken favorable action on the appeal, Ms. Helms-Hughes will be expected to participate in the conference as a full party.
