LICENSING SUPPORT SYSTEM ADVISORY REVIEW PANEL (LSSARP)
TECHNICAL WORKING (TWG) MEMBERS**

The Licensing Support System Advisory Review Panel (LSSARP) met in Las Vegas on December 12-13, 1994. During that meeting it was proposed and unanimously voted that the LSSARP form a Technical Working Group (TWG). Clark County Nevada, as one of the Affected Units of Local Government (AULG), volunteered to chair the working group and nominated Roger Hardwick, Systems Engineer from the Clark County Comprehensive Planning Department, Nuclear Waste Division to organize and chair this working group.

The charter of the LSSARP TWG will be to monitor the technical aspects of LSS development and evolution and advise the LSSARP on LSS technical issues and concerns at each meeting of the LSSARP.

The TWG consists of a representative from the Department of Energy (DOE), Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), Affected units of local Government (AULG), University of Nevada Las Vegas (UNLV) Information Science Research Institute (ISRI), National Council of American Indians (NCAI), industry technical advisor on information storage and retrieval technology, and a representative of the Yucca Mountain Project (YMP), Management and Operations contractor (M&O).

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The first task for this working group will be to individually review the LSS Requirements document that will be issued in Draft form by the M&O contractor during the last part of January, 1995. It is then anticipated that the TWG will meet in Las Vegas, Nevada, sometime during the middle to end of February, 1995 to discuss their individual findings and prepare a briefing for the LSSARP at their March 22 & 23, 1995 meeting in Las Vegas.

As chairman of this working group, I will distribute copies of the LSS requirements document as soon as it becomes available, compile comments from the working group members and put together the presentation to be reviewed by the TWG and ultimately presented to the LSSARP. Approximately two weeks after I distribute the LSS requirements document I will contact each TWG member individually to determine an agreeable date for the February TWG meeting in Las Vegas.

In addition, at the February meeting of the TWG, I would like to discuss the LSS Participants Commitments document that was distributed by the NRC at the December LSSARP meeting.



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
