ORDER
(Supplements Regarding Contentions)

Per the Commission's May 20, 2004 order referring the April 6, 2004 hearing petition of the Nuclear Information and Resource Service and Public Citizen (NIRS/PC) to the Licensing Board for further consideration, see CLI-04-15, 59 NRC __ (May 20, 2004), and in accord with the Board's April 15, 2004 initial prehearing memorandum and order, it is

ORDERED, that NIRS/PC shall have up to and including Thursday, May 27, 2004, within which to submit the supplemental information required under section I of the Board's April 15, 2004 initial prehearing order and to indicate whether it wishes to adopt any of the contentions of petitioner Attorney General of New Mexico (AGNM) or petitioner New Mexico Environment Department (NMED). Additionally, AGNM and NMED should indicate on or before that same date which, if any, of the NIRS/PC contentions each wishes to adopt.

In this regard, the Board requests that the NIRS/PC contention designation information be provided in a table format that correlates each of the NIRS/PC contentions with a redesignation that conforms to the groups specified by the Board (e.g., Contention 1.1 = Environmental Contention 1) and, in the event a contention falls into more than one group (e.g.,

Technical and Environmental) and has multiple bases, indicates which bases for the contention relate to which grouping.
