Separate from the pricing aspects, which Al mentioned in an earlier email to you, we can take and have taken UO<sub>2</sub>, U<sub>3</sub>O<sub>8</sub>, UF<sub>4</sub>, and DU resulting from the DUF<sub>6</sub> process in the concentrations and volumes you have described to this point.

We are also able to provide any of the Field Services support functions which may be required, such as, sampling, packaging, manifesting, shipping/transportation, etc. The specifications vary widely and are obviously, as you mentioned, dependant upon the conversion facility siting.

Our Clive operation handles truck or train shipments with any of the container/package options noted under item #14 on the PSW. Rail transport is the most efficient and least-cost method to our location for large volumes. The shipping schedule would become paramount to both site operations should the project come to fruition.
