The Commission* requested:

1. preparation of a draft Commission policy statement on licensing nuclear power plants over the next several months while the impacts of the accident at Three Mile Island are being evaluated. The statement should address both general principles to be applied in reaching licensing decisions and specific guidance for dealing with the seven near term operating license cases;

2. further development of supplemental resource provisional plans for dealing with normal staff activities from which personnel have been withdrawn to handle Three Mile Island related matters.
